Ode to Whiskey (as waltz and/or jig, AAB<sub>B</sub>x4)

Four couple longways set, 1s and 3s improper

2004

- A1 1-4 Taking hands in rings of four, balance in and out and circle left halfway;  
5-8 New middle couples (original ends) dance half a draw pousette to end up on the ends, *while* end couples, retaining hands and with the man leading, dance a quarter of the way around the outside of the set to end: TOP 3-4-1-2
- A2 1-8 Repeat to original places.
- B1 1-4 In original fours, neighbors back to back,  
5-8 Half hey for four on the sides, with hands, starting giving neighbor R-hand. End with the set inverted.
- B2 1-4 Circle eight to the left halfway,  
5-8 1s cast to the bottom of the set *while* the other three couples two-hand turn once round moving up one place.

Dave likes to dance this four times through in waltz time, and then four times in jig time.
